

COVID Vaccine Update:

Currently there are two COVID vaccines that have received Emergency Use Approval from the FDA. We have begun vaccinating high risk medical workers according to the State of NH distribution guidelines. Valley eagerly awaits the opportunity to begin vaccinating the public, and will be working with the State to develop those distribution plans. Under the State's guidance, we will provide instructions to all of our providers, as well as release our plan via our website and social media.

We understand that you may have many questions about the vaccine(s), including its safety, where you will be able to receive it, and when you might be able to get it. We are in the early stages of planning and cannot answer all of your questions today. Again, the latest information about the vaccine and our plans for distribution to our community will be available on the front page of our website at vrh.org and on our Facebook and Twitter pages. We will continue to share more information about who can get it, when it will be available and where it will be given.

Early supplies of the approved vaccines from Pfizer and Moderna are limited. These vaccines will require two doses, given 21 or 28 days apart depending on the vaccine. You will need to take both doses for the vaccine to be effective.

The best ways you can keep yourself and others safe right now are to continue wearing a mask, practice social/physical distancing, and to be vigilant about hand washing.
